Dear Parent/Carer

An exciting opportunity has arisen for your child to attend The National Theatre in London to watch an evening performance of Nye on Friday 18 July 2025. Nye, played by Michael Sheen, is based on the story of Nye Bevan, the founder of the NHS, and explores why its creation was, and remains so important in our society. This relates strongly to the themes contained within An Inspector Calls by J B Priestley which is one of the key texts studied in GCSE English Literature.

The students will come to school on Friday 18 July 2025 as normal, leaving after lunch and travelling by coach and car ferry to London for the 7.00 pm performance at The National Theatre. We will then travel back that evening and return on the midnight ferry. Students will need collecting at roughly 1.00 am from Carisbrooke College.

The member of staff in charge of the group is Mrs Smith accompanied by Mr Lyle, Ms Ryan and Miss Begley.

The cost of the visit is £58.00, which includes ferry and coach travel as well as entry tickets to Shakespeare's Globe. This price will be broken down into 3 installments:

- £20 due by Friday 24 January
- £20 due by Friday 28 February
- £18 due by Monday 31 March

This price does not include food so students will need to bring enough food and drink to last them for the whole day.

There are 46 spaces available. If your child wishes to be included in the visit, please log into the School Gateway and express their interest by Friday 17 January. Should more than 46 students wish to attend, the tickets will be offered by means of a draw. This gives all students a fair chance to organise funds.

Once interested/drawn students have been notified, payment should be made via Arbor. Whilst we appreciate that any contribution is voluntary, please be aware that this is the minimum contribution needed from each student for the trip to take place.
