1

Universal Provision

Inclusive, high-quality teaching for all

Differentiated outcomes and visual supports

Class based strategy cards constructed by teachers and the SEND team.

2

Early Intervention

Small-group teaching within class setting with targeted adult support, including the use of task planners, visual prompts, and structured classroom tools.

3

Targeted Additional

Monitoring phase. Includes evidence-based interventions (like phonics or emotional literacy) in 6 week blocks and an Assess-Plan-Do-Review cycle.

Parent/carer communication made where necessary.

4

Targeted Intensive

For students on the SEN Register.

Includes a *Pupil Learning Plan* with student voice and support from outside experts where necessary (like CAMHS or Autism Outreach).

Termly parent/carer communication.

5

Individual Provision

Highest level of support for complex, long-term needs which includes an EHCP.

May involve individual curriculum adaptations and alternative learning spaces where necessary.

Termly parent/carer communication.
